Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program..... 360-725-2857

The LIHWAP is available to low-income households and provides relief to two priority groups:
Households without current water services for the immediate restoration of services.
Households with existing arrearages to prevent disconnection of drinking water.

DSHS..... 877-501-2233

Two programs are available for families with children under 18 living at home.
AREN - for families currently receiving TANF (cash assistance), up to \$750
DIVERSION - for families who are eligible for TANF, but not receiving it, up to \$1250
