**Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

- In collaboration with the Operations Supervisor, provides direct supervision to the Water/Sewer Technicians.
- Plans, prioritizes, and supervises water and sewer system preventative maintenance programs, such as fire hydrants, air-vac assemblies, blow-offs, mainline valves, control valves, sewer manholes, sewer mainline cleaning, lift stations, etc.
- Plans, prioritizes, and supervises maintenance and repair of the District's fleet, equipment, and back-up power generators.
- Collaborates with the District's Operation Manager on budget & performance evaluations.
- Plans, prioritizes, and supervises water and sewer system repairs and new installations, such as mainlines, water service lines, fire hydrants, air-vac assemblies, blow-offs, etc.
- Oversees the District's Computer Maintenance Management System (Aktivov), ensuring all reports and work orders are accurate, legible, and completed in a timely manner.

**Physical Requirements:** Standing, sitting, climbing, walking, crouching, stooping, lifting & gripping. Extensive use of hands, eyes, ears, arms, legs & voice.
